We have great news!

The Susquehanna Council is now sending a contingent of **THREE** Troops to the 2010 National Jamboree and to top that we will be hosting 16 International Scouts and their leaders – talk about a fantastic opportunity!

In case you didn't know, the Boy Scouts of America will be celebrating 100 Years of Scouting in 2010. The 2010 National Jamboree will be held July 26<sup>th</sup> – August 4<sup>th</sup> and is expected to be the best, most exciting, fun-filled Jamboree ever! It will also be the last one to be held at Fort A.P. Hill in Virginia. This is truly a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity not to be missed.

The total cost for youth participants will be \$1500. This fee includes transportation, lodging and meals to and from the Jamboree; pre and post-jamboree activities; limited quantities of special uniform patches, t-shirts, hat, and backpack; and pre-jamboree training events.

We have a very limited number of openings for both Youth participants and Adult leaders. If you want to be considered for the contingent **the time to apply is NOW**.

### **Scout Qualifications:**

- Must be at least a First Class Scout by July 1, 2010.
- Be active in home troop for at least six months prior to July 1, 2010.
- Have completed the sixth grade or your 12<sup>th</sup> birthday is before July 1, 2010.
- Your 18<sup>th</sup> birthday must be after August 4, 2010.
- Successfully complete a personal health and medical record form.
- Be approved by your Scoutmaster and the jamboree selection committee.
- Be able to attend ALL pre-jamboree meetings and training activities.

The first meeting is scheduled for Sunday, January 18<sup>th</sup> – more info will be sent to applicants.

Interested youth must register online. Go to [www.bsajamboree.org](http://www.bsajamboree.org) and follow the links from there. To complete the on-line application there is a \$10 non-refundable processing fee payable by credit card. This \$10 processing fee does NOT apply to the registration fee.

Applicants then must print their registration confirmation, have it approved by their Scoutmaster and send it to the Scout Service Center with a \$100 deposit.
